The Canadian Chiropractic Association (CCA) is committed to supporting chiropractors for a healthier Canada – and that includes you, new grad!

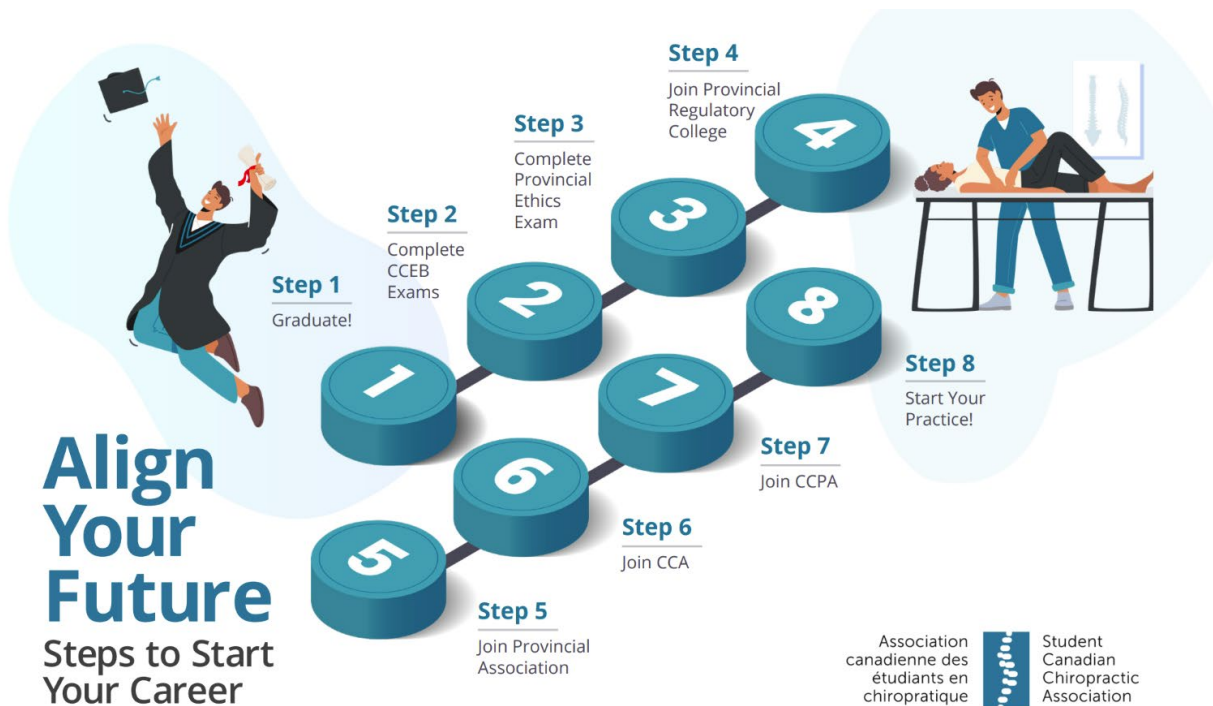
