2017 -18 Board Exam Funding Request

Doctor of Chiropractic students may use this form to request an adjustment to the Cost of Attendance (a.k.a. “budget”) to cover NBCE exam costs.

Board exam expenses are typically funded with Grad PLUS loans; since Grad PLUS loan funding is dependent upon your credit, please be aware the addition of board exams to your budget may not necessarily result in additional funding.

To be eligible for a budget adjustment for board exam costs, the following conditions must be met:

- You must be enrolled at least half-time as a Doctor of Chiropractic student during the term in which the board exam costs are incurred.
- Your board exam costs must be incurred while you are enrolled at UWS and within the current award cycle, which runs from July 2017 through June 2018.
- Only the first attempt at each exam can be funded—you are not eligible for additional funding for a re-take of all or a portion of a previously attempted exam.
- You must be making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) in accordance with the Financial Aid Office’s policies.
- You must meet all financial aid eligibility requirements.
