^{**}The "Books & Supplies" portion of the budget includes \$1400 USD for Doc Bag in Qtr 2 and equipment fee and \$824 USDin Qtr 1 for purchase of the computer required of all 1st year NMD students.

^{***} Board Exams are included in the budget once the application has been approved by the Registrar's office. Financial Aid can only pay for, and update the COA for required board exams that are paid for during the time the student is enrolled. Generally, students take part 1 during enrollment which has an estimated cost of \$525. Students start taking board exams at the end of Quarter 6.
