



UPDATED CAMPUS PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

**PLEASE NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO CHANGE TO PARKING RATES FOR
STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES DURING THE SUMMER TERM 2020**

INTRODUCTION

Parking and transportation are important to University of Western States students, faculty, staff, patients and visitors. On March 5, students were notified that in conjunction with the move to our new campus, parking rates would change starting July 1, 2020. In light of the current restrictions to opening the campus and the associated limited travel to campus, **parking rates will remain the same as winter 2020 term for the summer 2020 term.**

PARKING RATES: SUMMER TERM

Below is a summary of parking rates and the rates that will continue throughout the summer 2020 term:

Parking Space Description	Employee Monthly and Student Qtrly. Parking Rates	Annualized Parking Rates*
Student Surface Parking	\$35/qtr	\$140
Student Garage Parking*	\$35/qtr	\$140
Carpool - Surface	\$35/qtr	\$140
Reserved Spaces - Garage	\$15/month	\$180
Employee Garage	\$15/month	\$180

**Initially, 90 student spaces available in the parking garage.*

Through September 30, 2020, TriMet passes will be made available to students and employees per our current policy. Beginning October 1, 2020, consistent with the FY 21 budget, discount TriMet passes will be available from UWS for employees and students that choose not to purchase a parking permit. Before obtaining a discounted TriMet pass from UWS, employees must document their decision not to purchase a parking permit choice with the [office of human resources here](#).

NEW CAMPUS PARKING SYSTEM STRUCTURE

The surface parking lot will be designated for student parking permits. In addition, some disabled parking, visitor, carpool and clinic patient spaces will be allocated in the surface parking lot.

The garage parking lot will be designated for employees, with an initial additional allocation of 90 student spaces in the parking garage that will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. The parking garage will also include disabled parking spaces and reserved parking spaces. Parking garage permits will be required.
